

E-Waste Management













Read Japan Project











Poster Competition









Alumni Interaction









Constitution Day









Alumni Profile Briefing session










Career Opportunities and Recent Trends in Health Care Management

Market Research Survey on SMEs









During the event, the students also provided their inputs on how one could view the problem as an opportunity, through the movie. Overall, the student enjoyed this unique approach to address a social issue.




Challenges & Opportunities of SMEs

Christmas Party










