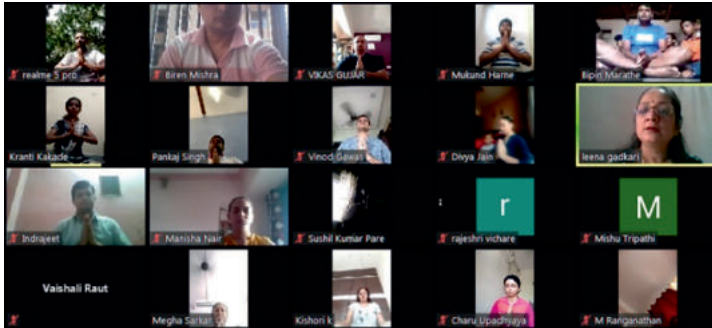

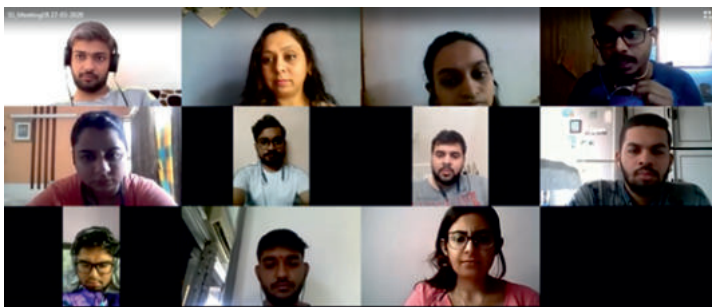
The Happiness Factor – The influence of DMS

TIMSR management has gone to the ground level to ensure that each of its employees & students are strengthening their immunity & developing themselves as mindful people.

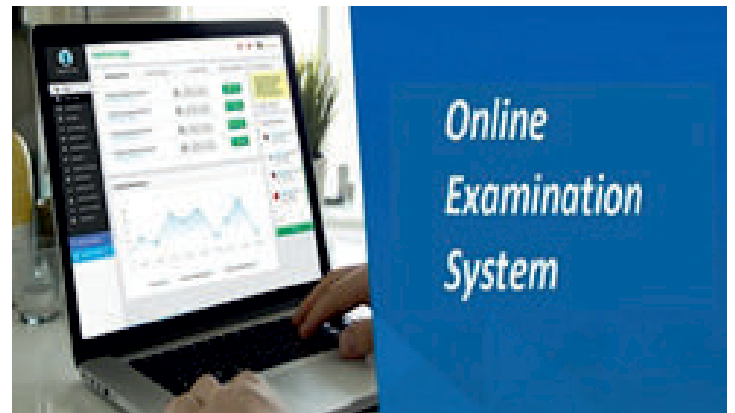
Educational Transformation at TIMSR (Technological Intervention)

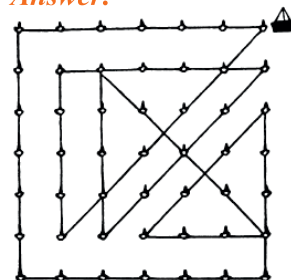
