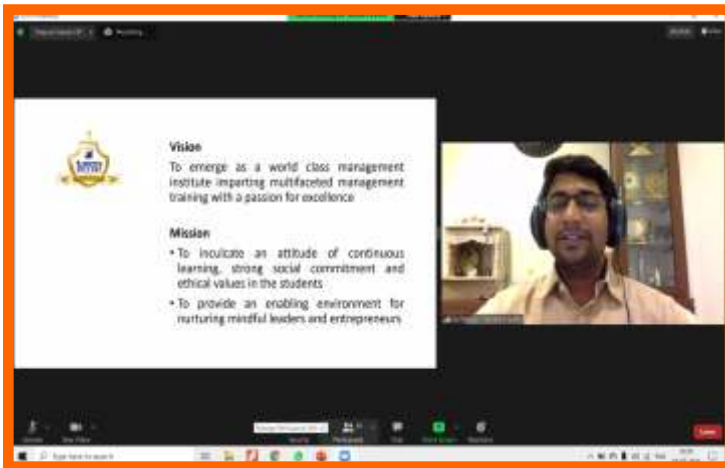
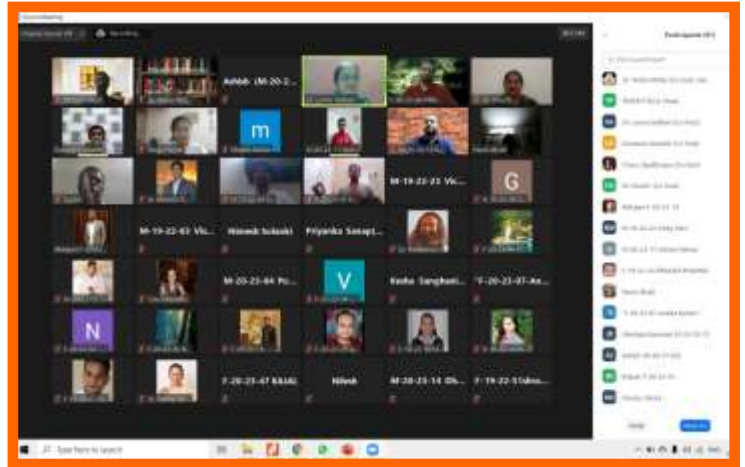
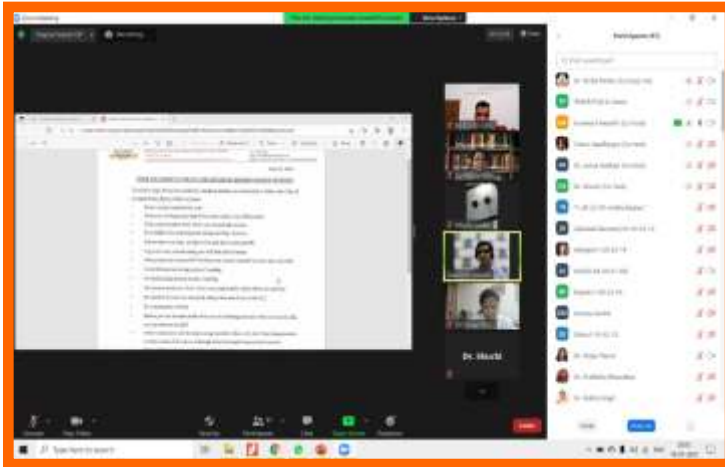


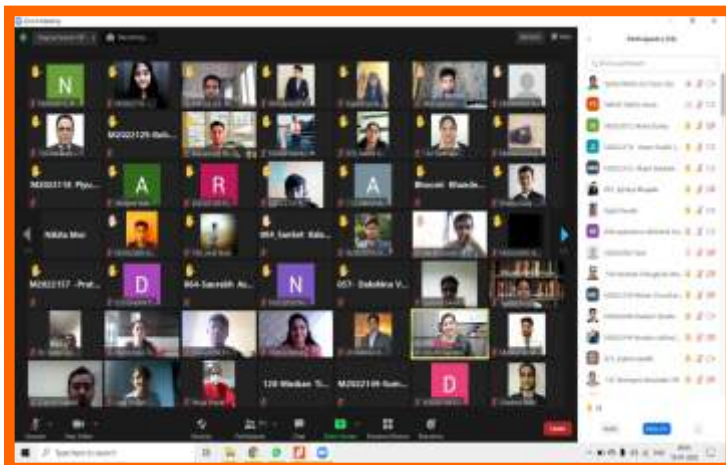
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Orientation Programme



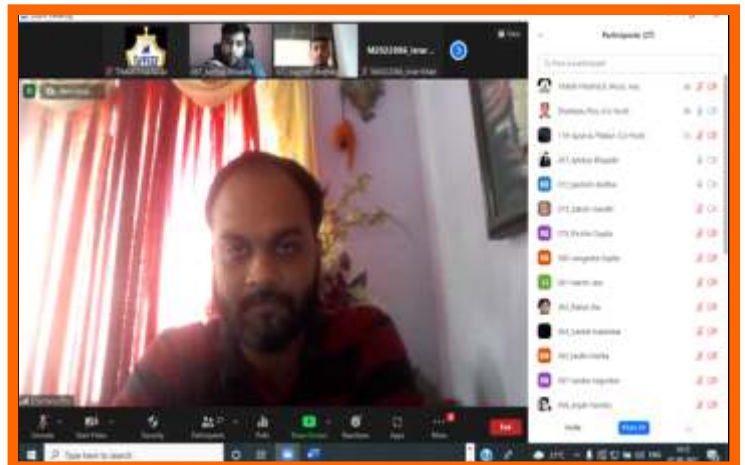
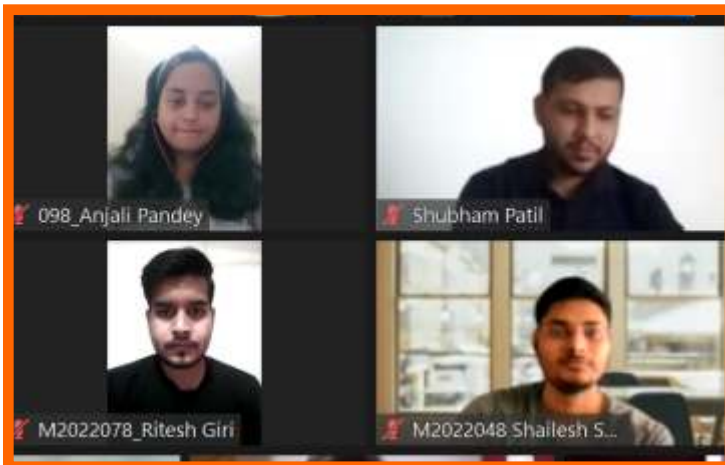
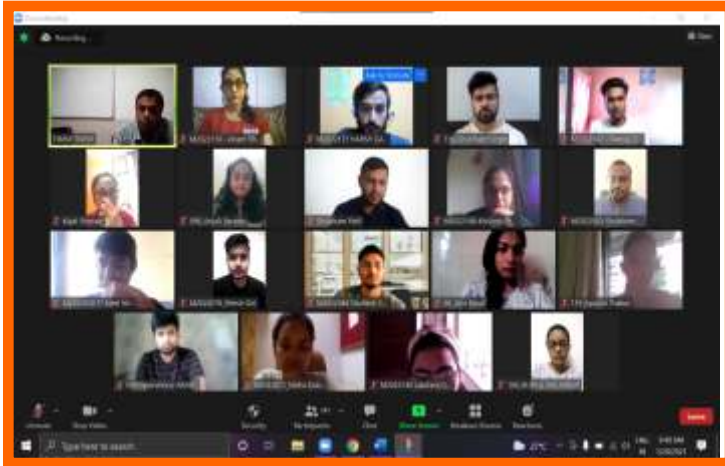

Summer Internship Programme



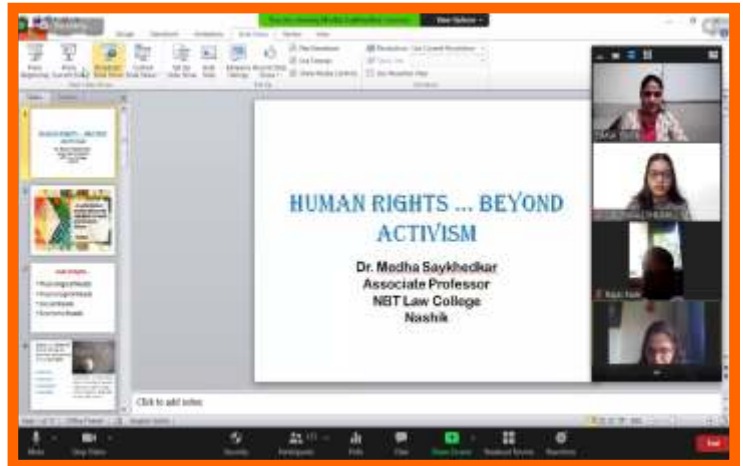
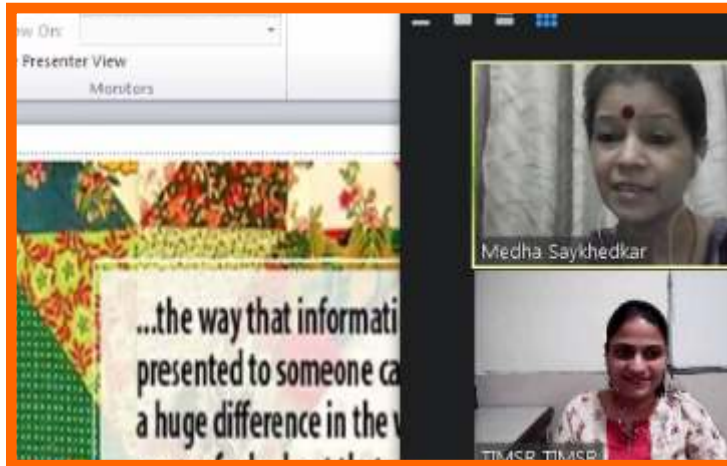

Writing Research Proposal



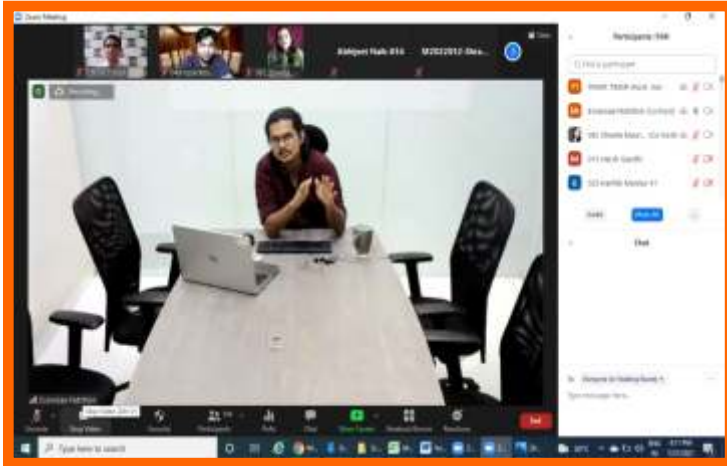

Human Rights Beyond Activism



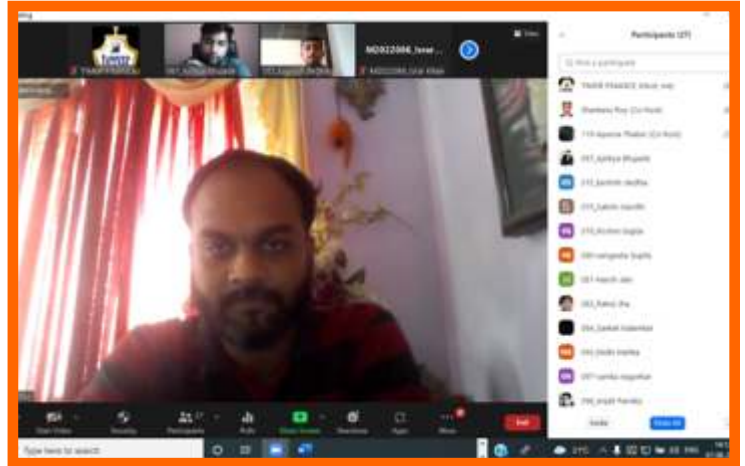
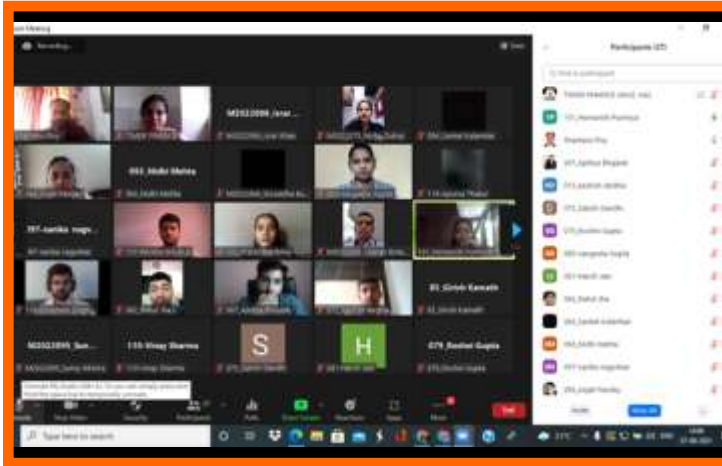

Workshop on Entrepreneurship



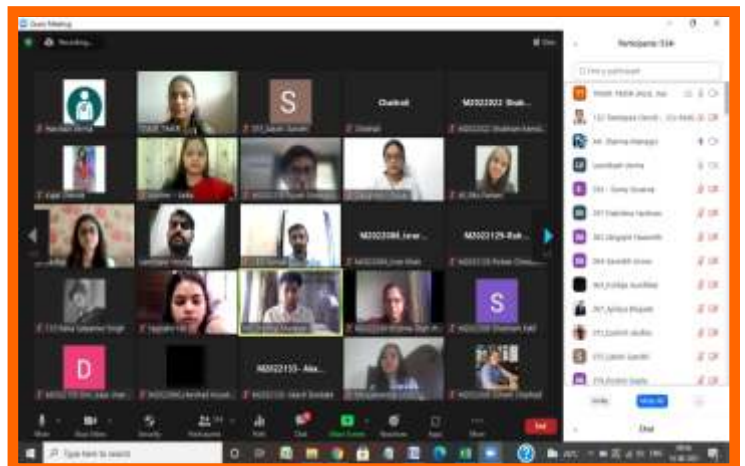
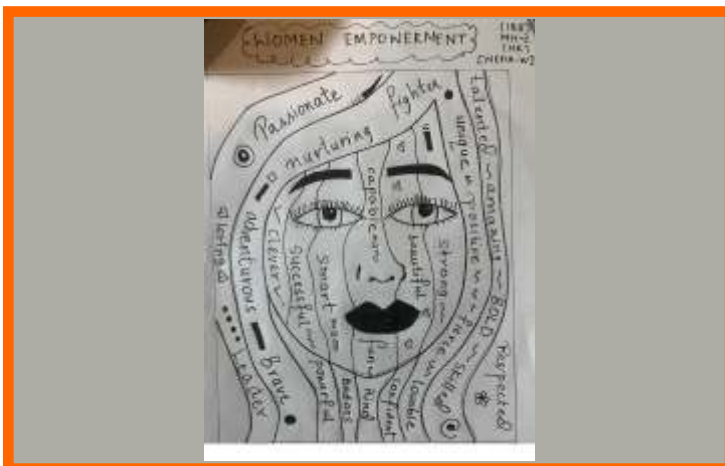

E-awareness session on Women's Empowerment and Gender Equality



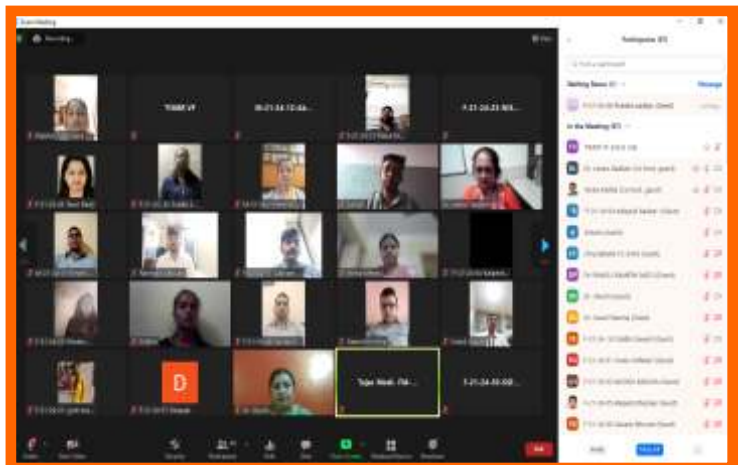
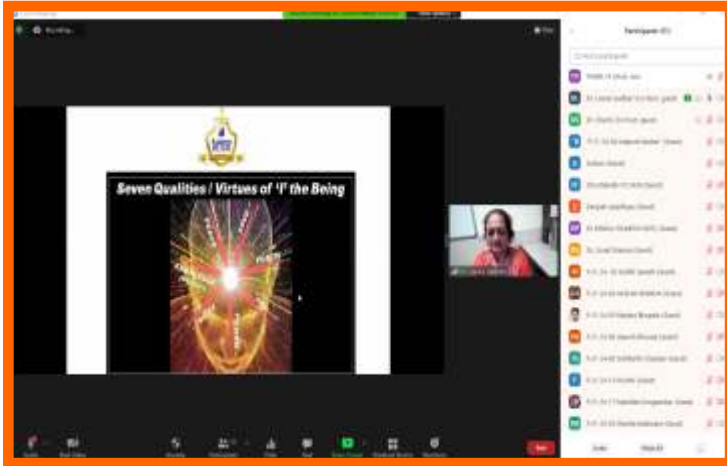

Induction Programme



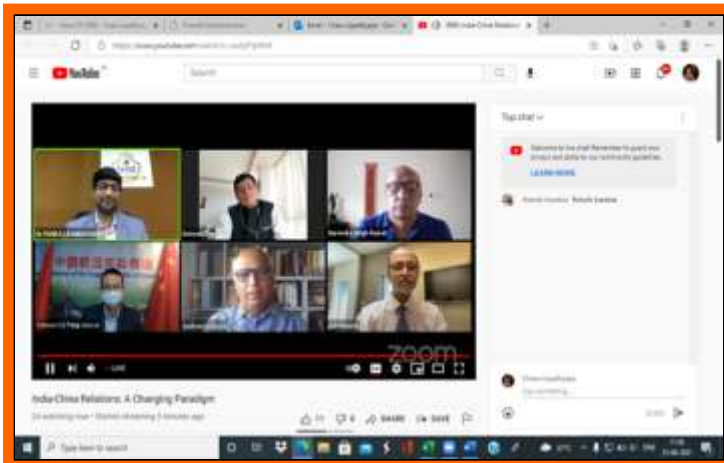

Finance Conclave - 2021



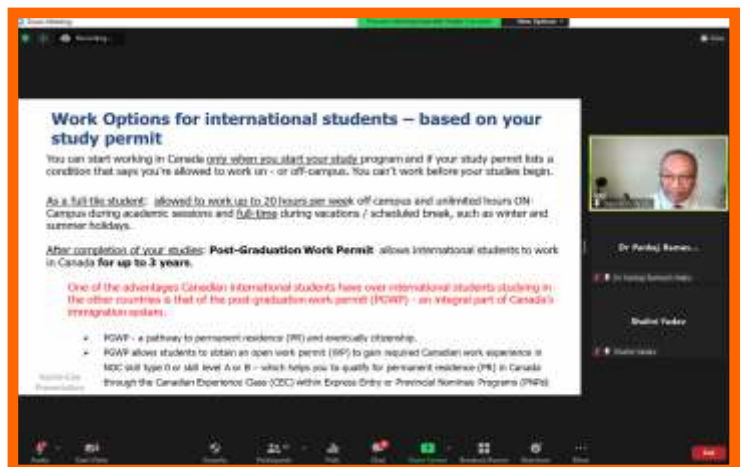
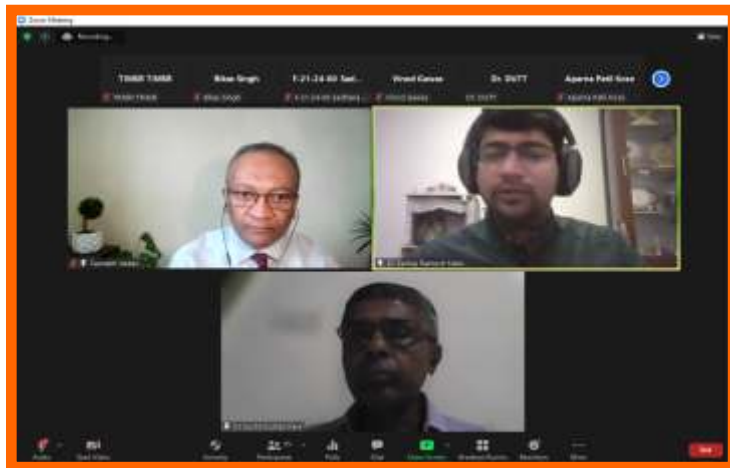
